Saturday, September 25th - Timber-Linn Park - Albany

As a participant in Oregon Good Sam Dog Walk 2010, you will be assisting Dogs for the Deaf, Inc., located in Central Point, Oregon, as they rescue dogs from shelters and train them to be Hearing Dogs, Autism Assistance Dogs, Miracle Mutts (special dogs for special people), Harmony's Hounds (dogs with special needs) and Career Change Dogs. Recipients of dogs pay no fees whatsoever!

This year's event is at a new location - Timber-Linn Park, 900 Price Road SE, Albany, Oregon, 97322. Finding the park is easy! Take Exit 233 from I-5 (coming from either north or south), head East on Highway 20. Go about ½ mile and turn left on Price Road SE (Lassen Toyota is on the corner). Go about ½ mile and look for the Dog Walk signs.

Here's the schedule of events:

9:30 to 10:30 - Check in for Dog Walk Participants.

10:00 to noon - Radio broadcast with KRKT Kountry radio. Coastal Farms is a sponsor.

10:30 - Walk begins. The approximately 2.5 mile (round trip) route is on a paved bicycle path.

At end of walk - Refreshment will be available for purchase. All proceeds will go to the Dog Walk Fund.

Noonish - Judging for competitions. Categories will include Best Costume, Biggest, Smallest, Owner-Dog Look-alike, Most Talented.
